

Front of Appeal Judgment Changes

Added Property Class

Added more comment lines

Paragraph in the middle was tightened up.

All judgement code descriptions should be noted on the front, not just 1E and 5F. These can go in the additional comment fields.

Next to a judgment code when the freeze act doesn't apply, it needs to state the code and "Freeze Act does not apply"

Back of Appeal Judgment Changes

Code 13 has been split out and 20 was added.

Code 18 and 19 were removed and reserved should they be needed again

Code 21 was added

Programming changes needed for Appeal Judgment

All judgement code descriptions should be noted on the front, not just for codes 1E and 5F. These can go in the additional comment fields.

For judgment codes that don't have the freeze act, next to the code it needs to state "Freeze Act does not apply". Ex 5A - "Freeze Act does not apply".

Box will need to be added to online screen to enter 1 tax year for code 6A. Even if multiple years exist, only 1 year should be entered.

When code 9b or 9d is used, the acreage change should be noted in the comments. Can a pop up note appear online to remind the board to enter the info?

For codes 2B, 5's, 6's, 7, 8's, 11's, 12's, 13A and 13 B, no judgment assessment should be entered. When applicable (12's, 13A and 13 B), the property class should be entered for the judgment.

Debits and credits for code 12A and 13A will need to look at class and judgment code and use entire original assessment instead of entering zero on the judgment.

A separate application needs to be filed for each type of appeal, and added year. If someone is appealing classification and assessment, that's 2 filings. If there's a prior and current year assessment

that someone is challenging the assessment on both, that's 2 filings. If that added is due to a class change, and they are also appealing the assessment on the 2 years, that's 4 filings now.
